



Remembering WeCAN in your Estate

Thank you for considering naming Western Communities Action Network (commonly referred to as “WeCAN”) in your estate plan. When doing so, it is very important that your bequest be accurately and clearly described so we can carry out your wishes as you intended. We encourage you to consult with us regarding the terms of your bequest to make sure that we will be able to carry out your intentions. Here is sample language for a bequest to guide you and your attorney as you construct your estate plan:

Bequest of a specific amount or specific property:

“I give, devise and bequeath to Western Communities Action Network, a Minnesota non-profit corporation, _____ (insert sum, percentage, description of property or remainder) to be used for its general (or specify) purposes.”

Residuary bequest:

“I give, devise and bequeath to Western Communities Action Network, a Minnesota non-profit corporation, _____ (“all” or “___%”) of the residue of my estate to be used for its general (or specify) purposes.”

* The above-examples are not the only ways to remember our organization at your passing. Should you wish to explore other gift planning techniques, I encourage you to consult your attorney.
